 - Mr Seutter shared that on December 20th at the Board meeting, the board will decide if Wye school name will remain the same or change. Based on stakeholder survey results and Board Opinion. If it is to change, A further stakeholder survey may be done with a short list of names (like Davidson) or it may simply be assigned based on another criteria. Communication will come from the school when we know more.

 - Parents have engaged WSC executive and requested a number of topics for new year meetings which may include bullying presentation from Ms Derosier. Levels of homework for our kids.
